COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2697

1 AN ACT TO CREATE SECTION 97-35-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO CRIMINALIZE THE FALSE REPORTING OF A CRIME; AND FOR RELATED 3 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. The following section shall be codified as
Section 97-35-47, Mississippi Code of 1972:

7 <u>97-35-47.</u> It shall be unlawful for any person to report a crime or any element of a crime to any law enforcement or any 8 9 officer of any court, by any means, knowing that such report is 10 false. A violation of this section shall be punishable by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed one (1) year or by 11 12 fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or both. In 13 addition to any fine and imprisonment, and upon proper showing made to the court, the defendant shall be ordered to pay as 14 restitution to the law enforcement agency reimbursement for any 15 reasonable costs directly related to the investigation of the 16 17 falsely reported crime and the prosecution of any person convicted under this section. 18

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2000.
