## SENATE BILL NO. 2697 (As Passed the Senate)

- 1 AN ACT TO CREATE SECTION 97-35-47, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO CRIMINALIZE THE FALSE REPORTING OF A CRIME; AND FOR RELATED
- 3 PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. The following section shall be codified as
- 6 Section 97-35-47, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 7 97-35-47. It shall be unlawful for any person to report a
- 8 crime or any element of a crime to any law enforcement or any
- 9 officer of any court, by any means, knowing that such report is
- 10 false. A violation of this section shall be punishable by
- 11 imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed one (1) year or by
- 12 fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or both. In
- 13 addition to any fine and imprisonment, and upon proper showing
- 14 made to the court, the defendant shall be ordered to pay as
- 15 restitution to the law enforcement agency reimbursement for any
- 16 reasonable costs directly related to the investigation of the
- 17 falsely reported crime and the prosecution of any person convicted
- 18 under this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2000.
