## SENATE BILL NO. 2701

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-53-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT ANY PERSON WHO HAS AT LEAST FIVE YEARS OF SOCIAL WORK PRACTICE AS AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC ENTITY BEFORE JULY 1, 1993, WHO IS ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN SOCIAL WORK PRACTICE AS AN EMPLOYEE OF A PUBLIC ENTITY ON JULY 1, 2000, SHALL BE ISSUED A LICENSE AS A SOCIAL WORKER IF THE PERSON APPLIES FOR THE LICENSE BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1, 2000; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. Section 73-53-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows:[RF1]

73-53-7. (1) Except as hereinafter provided, all 11 individuals not exempt from licensure who are not licensed under 12 this chapter are prohibited from performing services for 13 14 compensation for which licensure is required by this chapter, and 15 are also prohibited from holding themselves out to the public by any title or description of services set out in this chapter or by 16 any title or description of services likely to cause public 17 confusion with any title or description of services set out in 18 this chapter. 19

(2) Any person not licensed under this chapter on July 1, 20 1993, who is actively engaged in the practice of social work 21 22 before July 1, 1994, as an employee of the State of Mississippi or any agency, political subdivision or municipality thereof or any 23 24 community action agency or Head Start agency, and who is not eligible to be issued a license under subsection (3) of this 25 section, shall be issued a provisional license as a licensed 26 social worker by the board, if the person applies for such 27 provisional license before July 1, 1994, and, at the time that the 28

The 30 license shall be issued by the board upon application therefor, the submission of proof satisfactory to the board of the 31 applicant's employment in the practice of social work as provided 32 33 in this subsection, and the payment of the appropriate fee. Such 34 license shall be valid for a maximum period of two (2) years, but not to extend past June 30, 1995, during which time the 35 36 provisional licensee must pass the AASSWB social work examination 37 at the basic level.

(3) Any person not licensed under this chapter on July 1, 38 1993, who has been actively engaged in the practice of social work 39 for not less than five (5) years before July 1, 1993, as an 40 41 employee of the State of Mississippi or any agency, political subdivision or municipality thereof or any community action agency 42 or Head Start agency, shall be issued a license as a social worker 43 44 by the board, if the person applies for such license before September 1, 1994, and at the time that the application is made, 45 the person is so actively engaged. Any person who has the 46 required number of years of social work practice as an employee of 47 48 any of the specified entities before July 1, 1993, who is actively engaged in social work practice as an employee of any of the 49 specified entities on July 1, 2000, regardless of whether the 50 current employment position is designated as a social worker, 51 shall be issued a license as a social worker by the board if the 52 person applies for the license before September 1, 2000. 53 The license shall be issued by the board upon application therefor, 54 55 the submission of proof satisfactory to the board of the applicant's employment in the practice of social work as provided 56 in this subsection, and the payment of the appropriate fee. 57 58 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 59 and after July 1, 2000.
