SENATE BILL NO. 2708

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA, MISSISSIPPI, TO ISSUE BONDS IN THE MAXIMUM PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000.00 FOR 1 2 3 THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND EQUIPPING A WAREHOUSE FACILITY ON 4 PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. The governing authorities of the City of 7 Philadelphia, Mississippi, in their discretion, may issue general 8 obligation bonds of the city in the maximum principal amount of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) for the 9 10 purpose of providing funds for constructing and equipping a warehouse facility on property owned by the City of Philadelphia. 11 SECTION 2. Before the issuance of any bonds under this act, 12 13 the governing authorities of the city shall adopt and publish a resolution declaring their intention to issue such bonds pursuant 14 15 to Section 21-33-307, Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 3. This act, without regard to any statute not 16 17 referenced in this act, shall be full and complete authority for the issuance of bonds under this act and shall be construed as an 18 additional and alternative method therefor. All powers necessary 19 20 to be exercised in order to carry out this act are conferred. 21 SECTION 4. (1) Any bonds issued under this act and the 22 income from such bonds shall be exempt from all State of Mississippi taxation, except inheritance and gift taxes. 23 24 (2) Any bonds issued under this act shall be legal 25 investments for commercial banks, savings and loan associations and insurance companies organized under the laws of this state. 26 27 SECTION 5. Any bonds issued under this act shall be

No. 2708 00\SS03\R646 PAGE 1 validated in the manner provided by Chapter 13, Title 31, Mississippi Code of 1972, and to that end, the city clerk shall be directed to make up a transcript of all legal papers and proceedings relating to the bonds and to certify and forward the transcript to the State Bond Attorney for the institution of validation proceedings.

34 SECTION 6. Except as otherwise provided in this act, bonds 35 authorized under this act shall be issued in accordance with 36 Sections 21-33-301 through 21-33-329, Mississippi Code of 1972. 37 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 38 and after its passage.
