SENATE BILL NO. 2710

- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW CODE SECTION 17-25-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT ANY UNIT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT FROM CHARGING AN
- 3 IMPOUND FEE TO THE VICTIM OF A MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT UPON RECOVERY
- 4 OF THE STOLEN VEHICLE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 7 17-25-1, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 8 17-25-1. The governing authority of any municipality, and,
- 9 with respect to the unincorporated part of any county, the
- 10 governing authority of any county, are prohibited from assessing
- 11 any fee whatsoever to any owner of a motor vehicle either for
- 12 impounding or storage of the vehicle or for towing charges when
- 13 the owner retrieves the stolen vehicle after it has been recovered
- 14 by law enforcement officers or other employees of the municipality
- 15 or county.
- 16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after July 1, 2000.
