- TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF MARINE RESOURCES TO PURCHASE REAL PROPERTY FOR THE PRESERVATION OF COASTAL WETLANDS; AND FOR RELATED 3
- 4 PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 49-15-14, Mississippi Code of 1972:[LTR1] 7
- 8 49-15-14. (1) The department is hereby authorized to
- acquire interests in real estate and personal property through 9
- 10 purchase, donation, bequest or devise in furtherance of the
- purposes of Chapter 27 of Title 49 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 11
- for the preservation of the coastal wetlands. 12
- 13 (2) Before real estate is purchased or leased, the fair
- market value of the real estate shall be determined by the 14
- 15 averaging of at least two (2) appraisals by Mississippi Certified
- General Appraisers. The appraisals shall be paid for by the State 16
- 17 of Mississippi.
- (3) The department is hereby authorized to obtain abstracts 18
- and surveys, and to engage the services of attorneys or other 19
- 20 professionals to conduct the above described transactions. The
- 21 department is authorized to obtain title insurance on property
- purchased if, in the opinion of the executive director, the best 22
- interests of the State of Mississippi would be served. 23
- 24 In order to carry out its management responsibilities
- 25 over all state lands which are now or may hereafter come under its
- 26 jurisdiction, the department is authorized to grant easements and
- rights-of-way over and across any part of such state lands. 2.7

- 28 Easements and rights-of-way may be granted for such consideration,
- 29 and upon such terms and conditions, as the department may deem to
- 30 be in the best interest of the state, consistent with the use of
- 31 such lands for preservation and recreational purposes. Any
- 32 easement for a utility line shall be granted for that period of
- 33 time that the department deems to be in the best interest of the
- 34 management of such lands.
- 35 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 36 and after its passage.
