SENATE BILL NO. 2738

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-13-17, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE THAT MEMBERS OF THE HIGHWAY SAFETY PATROL RETIREMENT 3 SYSTEM SHALL RECEIVE CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR ALL ACTIVE DUTY 4 MILITARY SERVICE, NOT JUST MILITARY SERVICE DURING TIME OF WAR OR 5 MILITARY CONFLICT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 25-13-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 25-13-17. All persons who are covered under the terms of 10 this chapter on the date on which this retirement system is 11 established and who become members of the retirement system shall 12 cease to be members under the provisions of Sections 25-11-101 13 through 25-11-139 upon the effective date of this chapter, and 14 shall become members of this retirement system with full credit 15 for all prior service with the Highway Safety Patrol.

In computing the period of service of a member of the Highway 16 Safety Patrol, anything in this chapter to the contrary 17 notwithstanding, any member who served on active duty in the Armed 18 Forces of the United States, * * * or who served in maritime 19 service during periods of hostility in World War II, shall be 20 21 entitled to creditable service for his service on active duty in the Armed Forces or in such maritime service, provided he entered 2.2 23 state service after his discharge from the Armed Forces or entered state service after he completed such maritime service. The 2.4 25 maximum period for such creditable service for all military 26 service shall not * * * exceed four (4) years unless * * * 27 positive proof <u>can be furnished by such person</u> that he was

retained in the Armed Forces during World War II or in maritime 28 29 service during World War II, by causes beyond his control and without opportunity of discharge. The member shall furnish proof 30 satisfactory to the Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' 31 32 Retirement System of certification of military service or maritime service records showing dates of entrance into active duty service 33 and the date of discharge. No creditable service shall be granted 34 for any military service or maritime service to a member who 35 qualifies for a retirement allowance in another public retirement 36 system administered by the Board of Trustees of the Public 37 Employees' Retirement System based in whole or in part on such 38 military or maritime service. In no case shall the member receive 39 creditable service if the member received a dishonorable discharge 40 from the Armed Forces of the United States. 41 The credit for military service granted in this section shall 42 43 apply to all persons who have retired from the Highway Patrol and 44 who qualify for credit as outlined above, whether they retired

45 before or after <u>July 1, 2000</u>; but this provision shall not operate 46 to require any back payments of retirement.

47 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 48 and after July 1, 2000.
