## SENATE BILL NO. 2742

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-3-25, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE SENTENCING ALTERNATIVES IN A MANSLAUGHTER CONVICTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 97-3-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:[CSQ1]
- 7 97-3-25. (1) Any person convicted of manslaughter shall be
- 8 fined in a sum not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or
- 9 imprisoned in the county jail not more than one (1) year, or both,
- 10 or in the penitentiary not less than two (2) years, nor more than
- 11 twenty (20) years.
- 12 (2) In a conviction for manslaughter by culpable negligence,
- 13 the sentencing judge, in his discretion, may designate the
- 14 <u>defendant as a violent or nonviolent offender according to the</u>
- 15 proof of the case.
- 16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after its passage.
