1 2 3 4 5	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-23-147, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DIRECT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE AN ANNUAL RECOGNITION PROGRAM FOR SCHOOLS FOR PROVIDING FULL INCLUSION OF CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES IN ALL ASPECTS OF ACADEMIC AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. Section 37-23-147, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8	amended as follows:[LR1]
9	37-23-147. (1) The State Department of Education shall
10	establish goals for the performance of children with disabilities
11	that will promote the purpose of IDEA and are consistent, to the
12	maximum extent appropriate, with other goals and standards for
13	children established by the State Department of Education.
14	Performance indicators used to assess progress toward achieving
15	those goals that, at a minimum, address the performance of
16	children with disabilities on assessments, drop-out rates, and
17	graduation rates shall be developed. Every two (2) years, the
18	progress toward meeting the established performance goals shall be
19	reported to the public.
20	(2) To encourage the full inclusion of children with
21	disabilities in all aspects of academic and extracurricular
22	activities, the State Department of Education shall provide
23	special recognition to the schools receiving such designation and
24	their school districts. Examples of such recognition may include,
25	but not be limited to: public announcements and events,

certificates of recognition and plaques for teachers, principals,

superintendents and parents, and media announcements utilizing the

- 28 <u>services of Mississippi Educational Television</u>. This special
- 29 recognition shall be awarded to one (1) elementary, one (1) middle
- 30 school, and one (1) high school, based on entries submitted to the
- 31 <u>Mississippi Advisory Committee for Special Education by the</u>
- 32 <u>deadline of March 31</u>. These entries shall be in the form of a
- 33 report, not to exceed five (5) pages, listing name, address and
- 34 telephone number of the school district/school; teacher or staff
- 35 responsible for administering the program; type of position held
- 36 by each of these employees including credentials; description of
- 37 the program; number of students with disabilities included; type
- 38 <u>and level of severity of disabilities; number of students without</u>
- 39 <u>disabilities involved in the program; how long the program has</u>
- 40 been in operation; benefit of program to all students; and a
- 41 description of how this program could be replicated by other
- 42 school districts. Winners of the Exemplary Inclusion Program
- 43 contest shall be chosen by the Mississippi Advisory Committee for
- 44 Special Education in April of each year.
- 45 <u>Recognition shall be given to these schools during the May</u>
- 46 <u>Mississippi State Board of Education meeting each year.</u>
- 47 <u>Information on these exemplary programs shall be provided to other</u>
- 48 school districts and the general public through news releases, the
- 49 state department website, and other similar avenues.
- 50 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 51 and after July 1, 2000.
