## SENATE BILL NO. 2758 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT TO CREATE A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE "MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUND"; TO PROVIDE THAT MONEY IN SUCH FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED BY THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AT PORTS, AIRPORTS, PUBLICLY OWNED RAILROADS AND PUBLIC TRANSIT PROVIDERS IN MISSISSIPPI; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ALLOCATION OF SUCH FUNDS AMONG THE VARIOUS MODES OF 5 6 7 TRANSPORTATION; TO PROVIDE THAT AS A CONDITION PRECEDENT FOR THE 8 RECEIPT OF ANY MONEY FROM THE FUND, THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE PORT, AIRPORT, RAILROAD OR TRANSIT SYSTEM SHALL BE REQUIRED TO FURNISH 10% OF THE TOTAL PROJECT COST; TO PROVIDE THAT A CERTAIN 9 10 11 AMOUNT OF THE MONEY ALLOCATED TO AIRPORT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS 12 SHALL BE DIVIDED AMONG ALL AIRPORTS WITHIN THE STATE WITH 13 14 REGULARLY SCHEDULED COMMERCIAL PASSENGER SERVICE BASED ON 15 ENPLANEMENTS AT SUCH AIRPORTS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF 16 THE REMAINDER OF THE FUNDS ALLOCATED TO AIRPORT PROJECTS; TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI PORTS PROJECT SELECTION COMMITTEE; TO 17 18 PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SHALL SOLICIT AND EVALUATE APPLICATIONS FOR THE FUNDS ALLOCATED TO PORT 19 PROJECTS USING THE CRITERIA ESTABLISHED IN THIS ACT; TO PROVIDE THAT THE PORTS PROJECT SELECTION COMMITTEE SHALL SELECT PORT 20 21 22 PROJECTS FROM THOSE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION 23 DETERMINE TO MEET THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA ESTABLISHED IN THIS 24 ACT; TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI PUBLICLY OWNED RAILROAD PROJECT 25 SELECTION COMMITTEE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF 26 TRANSPORTATION SHALL SOLICIT AND EVALUATE APPLICATIONS FOR THE FUNDS ALLOCATED TO PUBLICLY OWNED RAILROADS USING THE CRITERIA 27 28 ESTABLISHED IN THIS ACT; TO PROVIDE THAT THE PUBLICLY OWNED 29 RAILROAD PROJECT SELECTION COMMITTEE SHALL SELECT RAIL PROJECTS 30 FROM THOSE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION DETERMINE TO MEET THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THIS ACT; TO PROVIDE THAT, 31 32 OF THE FUNDS ALLOCATED FOR PUBLIC TRANSIT IMPROVEMENTS, 30% SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO THE COAST TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND THE TRANSIT 33 AUTHORITY SERVING THE JACKSON METROPOLITAN AREA; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ALLOCATION OF THE REMAINDER OF THE FUNDS ALLOCATED TO PUBLIC 34 35 TRANSIT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELIGIBILITY 36 37 CRITERIA FOR PORT PROJECTS AND PUBLIC TRANSIT IMPROVEMENTS; AND 38 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 39 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. There is established in the State Treasury a 40 41 special fund to be designated as the "Multimodal Transportation 42 Capital Improvement Program Fund" into which shall be deposited such funds as may be designated for deposit therein. Unexpended 43 44 amounts remaining in the fund at the end of the state fiscal year

- 45 shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest
- 46 earned on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of
- 47 the fund. Money in the fund shall be expended by the Mississippi
- 48 Department of Transportation for capital improvement projects at
- 49 ports, airports, publicly owned railroads and public transit
- 50 providers in Mississippi.
- 51 (2) The Mississippi Department shall allocate the
- 52 expenditure of money in such fund each fiscal year among each mode
- 53 as follows:
- 54 (a) Forty percent (40%) shall be allocated for capital
- 55 improvements at ports;
- 56 (b) Twenty percent (20%) shall be allocated for capital
- 57 improvements at airports;
- 58 (c) Twenty percent (20%) shall be allocated for capital
- 59 improvements to publicly owned railroads;
- (d) Twenty percent (20%) shall be allocated for capital
- 61 improvements to public transit systems; and
- The Mississippi Department of Transportation may, in its
- discretion, divert not more than ten percent (10%) of the amount
- 64 allocated to a mode as provided in this subsection to another mode
- or modes based on priorities established by the department.
- 66 (3) As a condition precedent for the receipt of any money
- 67 from the fund, the governing authority of the port, airport,
- 68 railroad or transit system shall be required to furnish ten
- 69 percent (10%) of the total project cost; provided, however, that
- 70 when money from the fund is utilized to match federal funds the
- 71 Mississippi Department of Transportation may require such
- 72 governing authority to furnish an amount not to exceed fifty
- 73 percent (50%) of the required federal match.
- 74 (4) The allocation for specific projects for the various
- 75 modes shall be governed by the provisions of Sections 2, 3, 4, and
- 76 5 of this act.
- 77 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) Thirty percent (30%) of the funds allocated
- 78 to airport capital improvements pursuant to Section 1 of this act
- 79 shall be divided among all airports within the state with
- 80 regularly scheduled commercial passenger service. Each airport
- 81 shall be granted funds in the proportion that the number of

- 82 enplanements at the airport during the previous year bears to the
- 83 total enplanements for all commercial airports in the state for
- 84 the previous year. The number of enplanements shall be based on
- 85 enplanement statistics published by the Federal Aviation
- 86 Administration. The funds authorized in this section shall be
- 87 issued to the local airport authority for any capital improvements
- 88 on airport property which directly supports the operations of the
- 89 airport.
- 90 (2) The remainder of the funds allocated for airport capital
- 91 improvements pursuant to Section 1 of this act shall be disbursed
- 92 to general aviation airports in this state utilizing the selection
- 93 criteria of the Mississippi Department of Transportation.
- 94 <u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) There is established the Mississippi Ports
- 95 Project Selection Committee which shall consist of the port
- 96 director of each of the ports of the state, the Executive Director
- 97 of the Mississippi Department of Economic and Community
- 98 Development, or his designee, the Executive Director of the
- 99 Mississippi Department of Transportation, or his designee. A
- 100 majority of the membership shall constitute a quorum.
- 101 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall
- 102 solicit applications for the funds allocated to port capital
- 103 improvements pursuant to Section 1 of this act. The department
- 104 shall evaluate each application for funds using the selection
- 105 criteria established in Section 6 of this act. The department
- 106 shall call a meeting of the Ports Project Selection Committee for
- 107 the purpose of selecting projects for funding by not later than
- 108 September of each year. The committee shall meet and decide which
- 109 port projects shall receive funds from the fund created in Section
- 110 1 of this act and the amount of such funds. The committee shall
- 111 approve only those projects meeting the eligibility criteria as
- 112 determined by the Mississippi Department of Transportation.
- 113 <u>SECTION 4.</u> (1) There is established the Mississippi
- 114 Publicly Owned Railroad Project Selection Committee which shall

115 consist of the chief executive officer of each of the publicly

116 owned railroads of the state, the Executive Director of the

117 Mississippi Department of Economic and Community Development, or

118 his designee, the Executive Director of the Mississippi Department

119 of Transportation, or his designee. A majority of the membership

120 shall constitute a quorum.

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121 (2) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall

122 solicit applications for the funds allocated to publicly owned

123 railroads capital improvements pursuant to Section 1 of this act.

124 The department shall evaluate each application for funds using

125 the selection criteria established in Section 6 of this act and

126 such funds may be utilized only for projects on short line

127 railroads. The department shall call a meeting of the Publicly

128 Owned Railroad Project Selection Committee for the purpose of

selecting projects for funding by not later than September of each

130 year. The committee shall meet and decide which railroad projects

131 shall receive funds from the fund created in Section 1 of this act

132 and the amount of such funds. The committee shall approve only

133 those projects meeting the eligibility criteria as determined by

134 the Mississippi Department of Transportation.

135 <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) Of the funds allocated for public transit

136 capital improvements pursuant to Section 1 of this act, thirty

137 percent (30%) shall be allocated to the Coast Transit Authority,

138 thirty percent (30%) shall be allocated to the transit authority

139 serving the Jackson metropolitan area. Such funds shall be

140 utilized in accordance with the rules governing the use of Federal

141 Transit Administration funds.

142 (2) The remainder of the funds allocated for public transit

143 capital improvements shall be allocated by the Mississippi

144 Department of Transportation in compliance with Federal Transit

145 Authority rules for the rural public transit program.

146 <u>SECTION 6.</u> (1) In order for a port project or a publicly

147 owned rail project to be eligible for funds from the Multimodal

- 148 Transportation Capital Improvement Program Fund, a project:
- 149 (a) Shall be a capital improvement, not a maintenance
- 150 or operational expense;
- 151 (b) Shall be directly related to the operation of the
- 152 port or railroad in its modal role; and
- 153 (c) Shall be beyond the normal operating budget of the
- 154 project.
- 155 (2) Local expenditures for design or other preconstruction
- 156 costs may be used toward the local matching fund requirement. In
- 157 cases in which the preconstruction costs are significant, such
- 158 costs may be paid with money from the fund in the discretion of
- 159 the Executive Director of the Mississippi Department of
- 160 Transportation.
- 161 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 162 and after July 1, 2000.
