central priority as to where the veterans home shall be located, 28 29 with the northern region having first priority, the southern region having the next level priority and the central region being 30 third in order of priority. The object and purpose of the 31 32 establishment of such additional homes or domiciliaries shall be 33 to provide domiciliary care and other related services for eligible veterans of the State of Mississippi. The State Veterans 34 35 Affairs Board shall not be required to obtain certificates of need to carry out the intent and purpose of this section. 36 37 (3) The State Veterans Affairs Board is hereby authorized to establish additional state veterans homes (nursing/domiciliary) on 38 sites to be determined by the State Veterans' Affairs Board, with 39 the approval of the Department of Finance and Administration, when 40 funds are made available for such purpose by any agency of the 41 federal government or other sources.
