SENATE BILL NO. 2788

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-29-313, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE POSSESSION OF PRECURSORS OF METHAMPHETAMINE 1 2 3 PRODUCTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 41-29-313, Mississippi Code of 1972, is б amended as follows: [CSO1] 7 41-29-313. (1) (a) Except as authorized in this section, 8 it is unlawful for any person to knowingly or intentionally: 9 (i) Purchase, possess, transfer or distribute any 10 two (2) or more of the listed precursor chemicals or drugs in any amount with the intent to unlawfully manufacture a controlled 11 12 substance; 13 (ii) Purchase, possess, transfer or distribute any two (2) or more of the listed precursor chemicals or drugs in any 14 15 amount, knowing, or having probable cause to believe, that the listed precursor chemical or drug will be used to unlawfully 16 manufacture a controlled substance; 17 (b) Any person who violates this subsection (1), upon 18 conviction, is guilty of a felony and may be imprisoned for a 19 20 period not to exceed thirty (30) years and shall be fined not less 21 than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) nor more than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), or both fine and imprisonment. 22 (2) (a) It is unlawful for any person to knowingly or 23 intentionally steal or unlawfully take or carry away any amount of 24 anhydrous ammonia. 25 26 (b) It is unlawful for any person to purchase, possess,

28 or having probable cause to believe, that the anhydrous ammonia

29 will be used to unlawfully manufacture a controlled substance.

30 (c) It is unlawful for any person to purchase, possess,

31 transfer or distribute two hundred fifty (250) dosage units or

32 fifteen (15) grams in weight, as "dosage unit" and "weight" are

33 defined in Section 41-29-139, of pseudoephedrine or ephedrine,

34 knowing, or having probable cause to believe, that the

35 pseudoephedrine or ephedrine will be used to unlawfully

36 <u>manufacture a controlled substance.</u>

37 (d) Any person who violates this subsection (2), upon 38 conviction, is guilty of a felony and may be imprisoned for a 39 period not to exceed five (5) years and shall be fined not more 40 than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or both fine and 41 imprisonment.

42 (3) The term "listed precursor drug or chemical * * *" means 43 a precursor drug or chemical * * * that, in addition to legitimate 44 uses, may be used in manufacturing a controlled substance in violation of this chapter. Such term includes any salt, optical 45 isomer or salt of an optical isomer, whenever the existence of 46 such salt, optical isomer or salt of optical isomer is possible 47 48 within the specific chemical designation. The chemicals or drugs 49 listed in this section are included by whatever official, common, usual, chemical or trade name designated. The following are 50 "listed precursor <u>drugs or</u> chemicals * * *": 51

75	(4) Nothing in this act shall preclude any farmer from

79	(5) Nothing in this section shall preclude any wholesaler,
80	retailer or pharmacist from possessing or selling the listed
81	precursor drugs or chemicals in the normal pursuit of business.
82	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
83	and after its passage.
