AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-15-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ALLOW DISABLED JUDGES TO RETAIN THEIR BENEFITS FOR THE REMAINDER 1 2 OF THE TERM TO WHICH ELECTED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 3 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 25-15-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: [CSQ1] 7 25-15-3. For the purposes of this article, the words and phrases used herein shall have the following meanings: 8 9 "Employee" means a person who works full time for (a) 10 the State of Mississippi and receives his compensation in a direct payment from a department, agency or institution of the state 11 12 government and any person who works full time for any school 13 district, community/junior college, public library or university-based program authorized under Section 37-23-31 for 14 deaf, aphasic and emotionally disturbed children or any regular 15 nonstudent bus driver. This shall include legislators, employees 16 of the legislative branch and the judicial branch of the state and 17 "employees" shall include full-time salaried judges and full-time 18 district attorneys and their staff and full-time compulsory school 19 20 attendance officers. For the purposes of this article, any "employee" making contributions to the State of Mississippi 21 22 retirement plan shall be considered a full-time employee. A full-time salaried judge who resigns due to disability shall be 23 considered an employee for the remainder of the term to which 24 elected; "disability" is to be determined by the Mississippi 25 Commission on Judicial Performance, whose finding is to be 26

No. 2791 00\SS01\R1013 PAGE 1 27 supported by substantial evidence and shall be automatically reviewed by the full Supreme Court. 28 29 (b) "Department" means the Department of Finance and Administration. 30 (c) "Plan" means the State and School Employees Life 31 and Health Insurance Plan created under this article. 32 "Fund" means the State and School Employees 33 (d) 34 Insurance Fund set up under this article. "Retiree" means any employee retired under the 35 (e) Mississippi retirement plan. 36 (f) "Board" means the State and School Employees Health 37 Insurance Management Board created under Section 25-15-303. 38 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 39 and after July 1, 2000. 40
