- 2 TO LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF FISH CAUGHT IN SHRIMP TRAWLS THAT MAY BE
- 3 KEPT FOR PERSONAL CONSUMPTION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 49-15-96, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:[LTR1]
- 7 49-15-96. Vessels licensed under Section 49-15-64.5 may keep
- 8 <u>in whole</u>, for personal consumption only the following types of
- 9 fish which are caught in the shrimp nets or trawls of the vessel:
- 10 white trout, \* \* \* croaker, black drum, and ground mullet
- 11 (<u>sciaenidae</u> family) <u>sheepshead</u> (<u>sparidae</u> family) <u>gafftopsail</u>
- 12 <u>catfish (ariidae)</u> and flounder (bothidae and pleuronctide
- 13 families). The cumulative total of fish shall not exceed
- 14 <u>twenty-five (25) pounds</u>. In addition, a vessel may keep three (3)
- 15 <u>dozen blue crabs (portunidae family)</u>. This exemption for personal
- 16 <u>consumption does not apply to fish or crabs that are otherwise</u>
- 17 <u>illegal to possess or catch.</u>
- 18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 19 and after July 1, 2000.
