6	SECTION 1. Section 37-19-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:[RDD1]
8	37-19-7. (1) The allowance in the minimum education program
9	for teachers' salaries in each county and separate school district
10	shall be determined and paid in accordance with the scale for
11	teachers' salaries as provided in this subsection for the number
12	of teachers employed not in excess of the number of teacher units

15	the following number of years of teaching experience, the scale

28 29 It is the intent of the Legislature that any state funds made 30 available for salaries of licensed personnel in excess of the funds paid for such salaries for the 1986-1987 school year shall 31 32 be paid to licensed personnel pursuant to a personnel appraisal 33 and compensation system implemented by the State Board of The State Board of Education shall have the authority 34 Education. to adopt and amend rules and regulations as are necessary to 35 36 establish, administer and maintain the system. 37 All teachers employed on a full-time basis shall be paid a minimum salary in accordance with the above scale. (ii) From and after July 1, 1999, any licensed 96 school counselor who has met the requirements and acquired a National Certified School Counselor (NCSC) endorsement from the 97 98 National Board of Certified Counselors and who is employed by a local school board or the State Board of Education as a counselor 99 and not as an administrator. Such licensed school counselor 100 101 shall submit documentation to the State Department of Education 102 that the endorsement was received prior to October 15 in order to 103 be eligible for the full salary supplement in the current school 104 year, or the licensed school counselor shall submit such 105 documentation to the State Department of Education prior to 106 February 15 in order to be eligible for a prorated salary 107 supplement beginning with the second term of the school year. 108 However, the salary supplement authorized under this item shall be 109 discontinued two (2) years after the date on which the National 110 Board for Professional Teaching Standards offers a certification process for a Master Teacher certificate for school counselors, 111 112 and any school counselor receiving the salary supplement will be required to complete the Master Teacher certificate process under 113 114 item (i) of this paragraph in order to continue receiving such salary supplement. 115 (iii) From and after July 1, 1999, any licensed 116 117 speech-language pathologist and audiologist who has met the requirements and acquired a Certificate of Clinical Competence 118 119 from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association and who is 120 employed by a local school board. the actual cost of completing the process of acquiring the

160 certificate or endorsement, excluding any costs incurred for 161 postgraduate courses, not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) 162 for a school counselor or speech-language pathologist and 163 audiologist or school psychologist, regardless of whether or not 164 the process resulted in the award of the certificate or endorsement. A local school district or any private individual or 165 entity may pay the cost of completing the process of acquiring the 166 167 certificate or endorsement for any employee of the school district described under paragraph (a), and the State Department of 168 169 Education shall reimburse the school district for such cost, regardless of whether or not the process resulted in the award of 170 171 the certificate or endorsement. If a private individual or entity 172 has paid the cost of completing the process of acquiring the 173 certificate or endorsement for an employee, the local school district may agree to directly reimburse the individual or entity 174 175 for such cost on behalf of the employee.

- reimbursement authorized under this subsection shall be paid directly by the State Department of Education to the local school district and shall be in addition to its minimum education program allotments and not a part thereof in accordance with regulations promulgated by the State Board of Education, and subject to appropriation by the Legislature. Local school districts shall not reduce the local supplement paid to any employee receiving such salary supplement, and the employee shall receive any local supplement to which employees with similar training and experience otherwise are entitled.
- (d) The State Department of Education may not pay any process reimbursement to a school district for an employee who does not complete the certification or endorsement process required to be eligible for the certificate or endorsement. If an employee for whom such cost has been paid in full or in part by a local school district or private individual or entity fails to

- 193 complete the certification or endorsement process, the employee
- 194 shall be liable to the school district or individual or entity for
