SENATE BILL NO. 2950 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 7-7-42, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT THE STATE FISCAL OFFICER SHALL TRANSFER THE FUNDS 3 FROM THE CANCELLATION OF STATE OF MISSISSIPPI WARRANTS ISSUED AFTER JANUARY 1, 2000, TO THE ABANDONED PROPERTY FUND OF THE UNCLAIMED PROPERTY DIVISION OF THE STATE TREASURY; TO PROVIDE THAT 5 IF THE FUNDS REMAIN UNCLAIMED FOR FIVE YEARS, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL TRANSFER THE FUNDS BACK TO THE ORIGINAL SOURCE OF THE FUNDS; 6 7 TO AMEND SECTIONS 89-12-14 AND 89-12-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 8 IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 7-7-42, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 11 amended as follows:[HS1] 12 13 7-7-42. Any State of Mississippi warrant issued by the State Fiscal Officer against any fund in the State Treasury which has 14 15 not been presented to the State Treasurer for payment within one 16 (1) year after the last day of the month in which it was 17 originally issued, shall be null and void, the obligation thereafter shall be unenforceable and the State Fiscal Officer 18 shall not issue an additional warrant. 19 The State Fiscal Officer is authorized and directed to cancel 20 all outstanding warrants over one (1) year old at the end of each 21 month and shall notify the State Treasurer who shall remove such 22 23 warrants from his list of outstanding warrants. * * * 24 The State Fiscal Officer shall transfer the funds reflected 25 by the cancellation of the warrant to the Abandoned Property Fund authorized by Section 89-12-37 of the Unclaimed Property Division 26 of the State Treasury where the funds shall remain for five (5) 27

years. After five (5) years, if the funds are unclaimed, the

State Treasurer shall transfer the funds back to the original

- 31 This section is applicable to warrants issued on and after
- 32 <u>January 1, 2000.</u>
- 33 SECTION 2. Section 89-12-14, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 34 amended as follows:
- 35 89-12-14. (1) All intangible property, including, but not
- 36 limited to, any interest, dividend, or other earnings thereon,
- 37 less any lawful charges, held by a business association, federal,
- 38 state or local government or governmental subdivision, agency or
- 39 entity, or any other person or entity, regardless of where the
- 40 holder may be found, if the owner has not claimed or corresponded
- 41 in writing concerning the property within five (5) years after the
- 42 date prescribed for payment or delivery, is presumed abandoned and
- 43 subject to the custody of this state as unclaimed property if:
- 44 (a) The last known address of the owner is unknown; and
- 45 (b) The person or entity originating or issuing the
- 46 intangible property is this state or any political subdivision of
- 47 this state, or is incorporated, organized, created or otherwise
- 48 located in this state.
- 49 (2) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall
- 50 not apply to property that is or may be presumed abandoned and
- 51 subject to the custody of this state pursuant to any other
- 52 provision of law containing a dormancy period different than that
- 53 prescribed in subsection (1) of this section.
- 54 (3) The provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall
- 55 apply to all property held at the time of the effective date of
- 56 this section, or at any time thereafter, regardless of when such
- 57 property became or becomes presumptively abandoned.
- 58 (4) Insofar and only insofar as funds reflected by the
- 59 <u>cancellation of State of Mississippi warrants are unclaimed and</u>
- 60 presumed abandoned, the State Treasurer shall transfer such funds
- 61 out of the Abandoned Property Fund established by Section 89-12-37
- 62 to the original fund source after the expiration of five (5) years
- 63 <u>as required herein.</u>
- SECTION 3. Section 89-12-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 65 amended as follows:
- 89-12-37. (1) All funds received under the provisions of

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    this chapter shall forthwith be deposited by the Treasurer in a
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    special fund hereby established in the State Treasury to be
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    designated the "Abandoned Property Fund," except that the
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    Treasurer shall deposit in a separate special fund hereby
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    established in the State Treasury to be designated the "Abandoned
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    Property Claims Payment Fund" an amount not exceeding One Hundred
    Fifty Thousand Dollars ($150,000.00) from which he shall make
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    prompt payment of claims duly allowed by him as hereinafter
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    provided. Before making the deposits in either special fund, he
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    shall record the name and last known address of each person
    appearing from the holders' reports to be entitled to the
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    abandoned property and the name and last known address of each
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    insured person or annuitant and, with respect to each policy or
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    contract listed in the report of a life insurance corporation, its
    number, the name of the corporation and the amount due.
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    record shall be available for public inspection at all reasonable
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    business hours.
              There is created within the Abandoned Property Fund in
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         (2)
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    the State Treasury a trust to be known as the Historic Properties
    Financing Fund, which shall be used as provided in this section.
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    On July 1, 1999, Ten Million Dollars ($10,000,000.00) in the
    Abandoned Property Fund shall be set aside and placed in the
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    Historic Properties Financing Fund created herein. The principal
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    of the Historic Properties Financing Fund shall remain inviolate
    within the Abandoned Property Fund, and shall be invested in the
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    same manner as the remainder of the Abandoned Property Fund.
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    interest and income earned from the investment of the principal of
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    the Historic Properties Financing Fund shall be transferred
    quarterly to the Mississippi Landmark Grant Program account within
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the Historic Properties Trust Fund created under Section 39-5-23.

The transferred money shall be utilized by the Department of

Archives and History for the purposes as specified in Section

39-5-23(3).

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100	(3) Notwithstanding subsections (1) and (2) of this section
101	the funds reflected by the cancellation of State of Mississippi
102	warrants that constitute part of the Abandoned Property Fund shall
103	be transferred by the State Treasurer back to the original fund
104	source if unclaimed by the owner within the time specified in
105	<u>Section 7-7-42.</u>
106	SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
107	and after its passage.
