- SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 6
- 7 29-15-14, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 29-15-14. The natural and man-made sand beaches on the 8
- Mississippi Gulf Coast are a valuable and integral part of the 9
- 10 public trust tidelands and shall be preserved and maintained as
- 11 public sand beaches.
- The preservation of continuous, uninterrupted linear 12
- 13 stretches of public sand beach serves a higher public purpose for
- public use, access, recreation, view and enhancement of the 14
- 15 quality of life on the Mississippi Gulf Coast.
- 16 SECTION 2 This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after its passage.
