SENATE BILL NO. 3067

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF STATE GENERAL FUNDS TO THE
2 PAT HARRISON WATERWAY DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE
3 EXPENSES OF A FEASIBILITY PHASE STUDY OF MIXON'S CREEK TO BE
4 CONDUCTED BY THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS, FOR FISCAL
5 YEAR 2001.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Pat Harrison
10 Waterway District for the purpose of paying a portion of the
11 expenses of a feasibility phase study of Mixon's Creek to be
12 conducted by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, for the
13 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
14 June 30, 2001.....\$150,000.00

15 SECTION 2. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
16 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
17 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
18 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
19 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
20 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

21 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
22 and after July 1, 2000.
