SENATE BILL NO. 3068

- AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN SEGMENT OF SCHROCK ROAD IN ATTALA COUNTY AS A STATE HIGHWAY AND TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENT UNDER
- 3 THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR
- 4 MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The mileage of highway specifically
- 7 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
- 8 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
- 9 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.
- 10 (2) The following segment of road is designated as a state
- 11 highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
- 12 Transportation Commission for construction maintenance; and such
- 13 segment, together with the highways designated in Section 65-3-3
- 14 and 65-3-5 and all other laws adding links to the designated state
- 15 highway system, are declared to be the state highway system of
- 16 Mississippi:
- 17 Northern District-Attala County:
- 18 That gravel portion of Schrock Road near the Madison County
- 19 line in Attala County.
- 20 (3) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall
- 21 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
- 22 highways designated in subsection (2) of this section in the same
- 23 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in
- 24 Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3.
- 25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2000.
