- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37-9-71, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 8 37-9-71. The superintendent of schools and the principal of
- 9 a school shall have the power to suspend a pupil for good cause or
- 10 for any reason for which such pupil might be suspended, dismissed
- 11 or expelled by the school board. However, <u>for suspensions greater</u>
- 12 than ten (10) days, or dismissals, the school board shall provide
- 13 the student a due process hearing, either before the board or its
- 14 <u>designee</u>. * * *
- 15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after July 1, 2000.
