SENATE BILL NO. 3139

- AN ACT TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN SEGMENTS OF MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY
- 2 28 AND U.S. HIGHWAY 61 IN JEFFERSON COUNTY AS STATE HIGHWAYS AND
- 3 TO PLACE SUCH SEGMENTS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI
- 4 TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FOR MAINTENANCE; AND FOR RELATED
- 5 PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The mileage of highway specifically
- 8 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
- 9 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
- 10 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3.
- 11 (2) The following highways are designated as a state highway
- 12 and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
- 13 Transportation Commission for maintenance; and such highways,
- 14 together with the highways designated in Section 65-3-3 and 65-3-5
- 15 and all other laws adding links to the designated state highway
- 16 system, are declared to be the state highway system of
- 17 Mississippi:
- 18 Central District-Jefferson County:
- 19 Those portions of Mississippi Highway 28 and U.S. Highway 61
- 20 in Jefferson County that were maintained prior to July 1, 2000 by
- 21 the City of Fayette and Jefferson County.
- 22 (3) The Mississippi Department of Transportation shall
- 23 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
- 24 highways designated in subsection (2) of this section in the same
- 25 manner and upon the same terms and conditions as set out in
- 26 Sections 65-1-75, 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3.
- 27 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

28 and after July 1, 2000.
