SENATE BILL NO. 3167

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
2 AUTHORIZE AN ANNUAL SALARY SUPPLEMENT FOR ANY MEMBER OF THE BOARD
3 OF SUPERVISORS WHO HOLDS A VALID CERTIFICATE FOR COMPLETION OF THE
4 LEADERSHIP PROGRAM FOR COUNTY SUPERVISORS AS ADMINISTERED BY THE
5 CENTER FOR GOVERNMENTAL TECHNOLOGY, MISSISSIPPI STATE UNIVERSITY
6 EXTENSION SERVICE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. Section 25-3-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9 amended as follows:[JMR1]

10 25-3-13. The salaries of the members of the boards of
11 supervisors of the various counties are hereby fixed as full
12 compensation for their services.

13 The annual salary of each member of the board of supervisors
14 shall be based upon the total assessed valuation of his respective
15 county for the preceding taxable year in the following categories
16 and for the following amounts:

17 (a) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
18 less than Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), a salary of
19 Twenty-three Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars
20 (\$23,529.00);

21 (b) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
22 at least Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), but less than
23 Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00), a salary of
24 Twenty-four Thousand One Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars
25 (\$24,137.00);

26 (c) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
27 at least Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00), but less
28 than Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00), a salary of

29 Twenty-four Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-four Dollars

30 (\$24,744.00);

31 (d) For counties having a total assessed valuation of

32 at least Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00), but less

33 than Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), a salary of

34 Twenty-six Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-nine Dollars (\$26,869.00);

35 (e) For counties having a total assessed valuation of

36 at least Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), but less than

37 Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), a salary of

38 Twenty-eight Thousand Eighty-three Dollars (\$28,083.00);

39 (f) For counties having a total assessed valuation of

40 at least Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), but less

41 than One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), a

42 salary of Twenty-eight Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-four Dollars

43 (\$28,994.00);

44 (g) For counties having a total assessed valuation of

45 One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), but

46 less than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00), a

47 salary of Thirty-three Thousand Five Hundred Forty-eight Dollars

48 (\$33,548.00);

49 (h) For counties having a total assessed valuation of

50 Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00) or more, a salary

51 of Thirty-seven Thousand Three Hundred Forty-three Dollars

52 (\$37,343.00).

53 When any member of the board of supervisors holds a valid

54 certificate for completion of the Leadership Program for County

55 Supervisors as administered by the Center for Governmental

56 Technology, Mississippi State University Extension Service, he may

57 receive an additional One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars

58 (\$1,500.00) annually beginning the next fiscal year after

59 completion.

60 The salary of the members of the board of supervisors shall

61 not be increased under this section until the board of supervisors

62 shall have passed a resolution stating the amount of the increase

63 and spread it on its minutes.

64 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi

65 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,

66 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
67 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
68 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
69 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
70 extended.

71 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
72 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
73 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
