SENATE BILL NO. 3167

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-3-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE AN ANNUAL SALARY SUPPLEMENT FOR ANY MEMBER OF THE BOARD 1 2 3 OF SUPERVISORS WHO HOLDS A VALID CERTIFICATE FOR COMPLETION OF THE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM FOR COUNTY SUPERVISORS AS ADMINISTERED BY THE 4 CENTER FOR GOVERNMENTAL TECHNOLOGY, MISSISSIPPI STATE UNIVERSITY 5 EXTENSION SERVICE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 25-3-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 9 amended as follows:[JMR1] 25-3-13. The salaries of the members of the boards of 10 11 supervisors of the various counties are hereby fixed as full compensation for their services. 12 The annual salary of each member of the board of supervisors 13 14 shall be based upon the total assessed valuation of his respective county for the preceding taxable year in the following categories 15 and for the following amounts: 16 (a) For counties having a total assessed valuation of 17 18 less than Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), a salary of Twenty-three Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-nine Dollars 19 (\$23,529.00); 20 21 (b) For counties having a total assessed valuation of at least Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00), but less than 22 Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00), a salary of 23 2.4 Twenty-four Thousand One Hundred Thirty-seven Dollars 25 (\$24,137.00); 26 (c) For counties having a total assessed valuation of at least Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00), but less 27 than Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00), a salary of 28

31 (d) For counties having a total assessed valuation of 32 at least Thirty-five Million Dollars (\$35,000,000.00), but less 33 than Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), a salary of 34 Twenty-six Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-nine Dollars (\$26,869.00);

35 (e) For counties having a total assessed valuation of
36 at least Fifty Million Dollars (\$50,000,000.00), but less than
37 Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), a salary of
38 Twenty-eight Thousand Eighty-three Dollars (\$28,083.00);

(f) For counties having a total assessed valuation of at least Seventy-five Million Dollars (\$75,000,000.00), but less than One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), a salary of Twenty-eight Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-four Dollars (\$28,994.00);

44 (g) For counties having a total assessed valuation of 45 One Hundred Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$125,000,000.00), but 46 less than Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00), a 47 salary of Thirty-three Thousand Five Hundred Forty-eight Dollars 48 (\$33,548.00);

49 (h) For counties having a total assessed valuation of 50 Three Hundred Million Dollars (\$300,000,000.00) or more, a salary 51 of Thirty-seven Thousand Three Hundred Forty-three Dollars 52 (\$37,343.00).

53 When any member of the board of supervisors holds a valid 54 certificate for completion of the Leadership Program for County 55 Supervisors as administered by the Center for Governmental 56 Technology, Mississippi State University Extension Service, he may 57 receive an additional One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars 58 (\$1,500.00) annually beginning the next fiscal year after 59 completion.

The salary of the members of the board of supervisors shall not be increased under this section until the board of supervisors shall have passed a resolution stating the amount of the increase and spread it on its minutes.

64 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi 65 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,

No. 3167 00\SS01\R1239 PAGE 2 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
