SENATE BILL NO. 3189 (As Passed the Senate)

- AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 45-3-12, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO PROVIDE A 1
- 3 DISTINCTIVE MARKER TO BE PLACED ON THE TOMBSTONE OF ANY TROOPER
- KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 45-3-12, Mississippi Code of 1972: 7
- 45-3-12. (1) The commissioner is hereby authorized to 8
- provide a distinctive marker to be placed on the tombstone of any 9
- 10 trooper killed in the line of duty upon request of the trooper's
- 11 next-of-kin.
- (2) There is established in the State Treasury a special 12
- 13 fund to be known as the Troopers' Tombstone Marker Fund. The fund
- shall be funded by an initial appropriation of Five Thousand 14
- 15 Dollars (\$5,000.00), and shall be comprised of any additional
- funds made available by the Legislature or by donation, 16
- 17 contribution, gift or any other source. The Department of Public
- Safety shall be responsible for the management of the fund and the 18
- disbursement for payments for tombstone markers authorized under 19
- this section. 20
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 2.1
- and after July 1, 2000. 2.2
