6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9	Treasury to the credit of Community Services Block Grant Funds not
LO	otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Department of
L1	Corrections for the purpose of providing funds to operate an
L2	intensive supervision program for juveniles, as authorized in
L3	Senate Bill No. 3199, 2000 Regular Session, for the fiscal year
L4	beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001
L5	\$1,500,000.00.
L6	It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi
L7	Department of Corrections shall have the authority to use a
L8	portion of the funds appropriated in this section to reimburse the
L9	Mississippi Department of Human Services for any expenses incurred
20	by that department for assisting in the establishment and
21	operating of the intensive supervision program for juveniles, as
22	authorized in Senate Bill No. 3199, 2000 Regular Session.
23	SECTION 2. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
24	the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
25	as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
26	Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
27	upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers

- 28 in the manner provided by law.
- 29 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
