3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
4	SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
5	may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
6	State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the
7	expenses of the Department of Finance and Administration for the
8	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000 and ending June 30, 2001
9	\$ 14,875,799.00.
10	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
12	Treasury to the credit of the Department of Finance and
13	Administration for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred
14	in the operation of the various offices of the department for the
15	fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000 and ending June 30, 2001
16	\$ 15,870,183.00.
17	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
18	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2, the amount of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00), or 36 37 so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be expended for premium payments for flood insurance on state-owned facilities. However, 38 39 no such premium shall be paid until reviewed and approved by the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management. Said 40 41 payments are to be made from accrued interest earnings from loans under the Disaster Assistance Program. 42

SECTION 5. SECTION 7. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year

- 87 SECTION 8. The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property
- 88 Management of the Office of General Services is hereby expressly
- 89 authorized and empowered to receive, budget and expend any state,
- 90 local or other source funds designated for supplemental funding of
- 91 construction and/or repairs and renovation projects.
- 92 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the
- 93 following amounts are authorized to be spent out of the Statewide
- 94 Cost Allocation Fund No. 3143 by the Department of Finance and
- 95 Administration:
- 96 (a) One Hundred Fifty-six Thousand One Hundred Seventy

- 97 Dollars (\$156,170.00) for the purpose of defraying computer
- 98 expenses.
- 99 (b) Six Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand One Hundred
- 100 Ninety-four Dollars (\$628,194.00) for the purpose of defraying the
- 101 cost of the acquisition, development and implementation of the
- 102 Statewide Automated Accounting System.
- 103 (c) One Hundred Fifty-three Thousand Four Hundred
- 104 Dollars (\$153,400.00) for an imaging/electronic processing
- 105 feasibility study and implementation.
- 106 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Two
- 107 Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$295,000.00) is authorized
- 108 to be spent out of the Local Disaster Loan Fund No. 3144 by the
- 109 Department of Finance and Administration for the purpose of
- 110 defraying the cost of the Air Transport Services.
- 111 SECTION 11. The Office of Capitol Facilities, Department of
- 112 Finance and Administration, is hereby expressly authorized and
- 113 empowered to receive funds from state agencies for the rent of
- 114 office space in the Eldon Bolton Office Building in Biloxi,
- 115 Mississippi, and the State Service Center in Hattiesburg,
- 116 Mississippi. The Office of Capitol Facilities is further
- 117 authorized and empowered to budget and expend any such funds
- 118 received to operate and maintain, and up to Five Dollars (\$5.00)
- 119 per square foot of rental receipts to finish tenant space, in the
- 120 Eldon Bolton Office Building in Biloxi, Mississippi, and the State
- 121 Service Center in Hattiesburg, Mississippi, as state office
- 122 buildings. Monies received for rent of such office space are to
- 123 be deposited in a special fund in the State Treasury. Any funds
- 124 on hand at the end of the fiscal year shall lapse into the State
- 125 General Fund.
- 126 SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 127 Department of Finance and Administration shall maintain complete
- 128 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 129 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be

in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal 130 Year 2000. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 131 132 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2002 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 133 134 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2001 budget request process. 135 136 SECTION 13. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 137 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 138 139 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

140 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from

143 and after July 1, 2000.
