1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING COMMISSION, FOR FISCAL YEAR 3 2001.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Gaming Commission, for 8 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 9 10 2001.....\$ 5,538,077.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 13 funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Gaming Commission which are collected by or otherwise become 14 available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 15 Commission for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 16 June 30, 2001.....\$ 5,030,582.00. 17 SECTION 3. 43	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
44	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
45	Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001
46	funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions

47 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the

Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 48 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 49 50 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 51 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 52 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 53 54 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 55 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 56 57 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 58 59 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which

S. B. No. 3243 00\SS05\A182 PAGE 2 60 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 61 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 62 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

63 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 64 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

69 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One 70 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) is hereby authorized to be 71 transferred to the Mississippi Council on Compulsive Gambling, a 72 nonprofit organization.

73 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 74 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 75 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 76 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 77 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 78 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from 79 80 and after July 1, 2000.
