30 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 31 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 32 33 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 34 35 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 36 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 37 38 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 39 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 40 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 41 42 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 43 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 44 45 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 46 47 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 48 49 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 50 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 51 52 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 53 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 54 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 55
