SENATE BILL NO. 3252
(As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE
2 STATE TREASURER'S OFFICE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the
6 State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the
7 expenses of the office of the State Treasurer for the fiscal year
8 beginning July 1, 2000 and ending June 30, 2001.....
9\$ 730,977.00.

10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the special
12 fund entitled Abandoned Property Fund in the State Treasury for
13 the purpose of defraying expenses of the State Treasurer in
14 administering the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property and
15 certain other expenses of the office, for the fiscal year
16 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....
17\$ 1,591,768.00.

18 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19 Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
20 be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
21 expenditure:

42 SECTION 4. In addition to all other sums herein
 43 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
 44 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
 45 Treasury to the credit of the Education Improvement Trust Fund No.
 46 3219 for the purpose of investing funds for the fiscal year
 47 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....

49 SECTION 5. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
 50 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
 51 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable
 52 College Tuition Administrative Fund to defray the costs of the
 53 Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition Program for the
 54 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....

56 With the funds appropriated in this section, the following
 57 positions are authorized:

58 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:

60 SECTION 6. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated,
61 the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
62 hereby appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury to the
63 credit of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition Trust
64 Fund for the purpose of paying all amounts due for prepaid tuition
65 contracts of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition
66 Program, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
67 June 30, 2001.....\$ 1,000,000.00.

68 SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
69 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
70 Treasury to the credit of the Health Care Expendable Fund, created
71 under House Bill No. 519, 1999 Regular Session, for the purpose of
72 defraying the expenses of the Office of the State Treasurer for
73 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30,
74 2001\$ 177,604.00.

75 With the funds appropriated in this section, the following
76 positions are authorized:

77 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:

78 Permanent: Full Time 2

79 SECTION 8. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the
80 intention of the Legislature that it shall be the agency's
81 responsibility to make certain that funds required to be
82 appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not
83 exceed Fiscal Year 2001 funds appropriated for that purpose,
84 unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year
85 2002 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data
86 provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel
87 Board shall determine and publish the projected annual cost to
88 fully fund all appropriated positions in compliance with the
89 provisions of this act. It shall be the responsibility of the
90 agency head to insure that no single personnel action increases
91 this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001
92 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the

93 end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines
94 that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency
95 to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001
96 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only
97 those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the
98 appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel
99 Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are
100 met.

101 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
102 State Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend
103 an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
104 (\$500,000.00) from administrative fees charged for the
105 administration of the Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College
106 Tuition Program and deposited in the Mississippi Prepaid
107 Affordable College Tuition Administrative Fund. Such funds shall
108 be escalated in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
109 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
110 with the escalation of federal funds.

111 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
112 State Treasurer is hereby authorized to accept, budget and expend
113 funds for the purpose of defraying the cost of administering the
114 Mississippi Prepaid Affordable College Tuition Program in an
115 amount not to exceed Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00)
116 which become available from interest earnings on any funds
117 authorized for administration of said program. Such funds shall
118 be escalated in accordance with the rules and regulations of the
119 Department of Finance and Administration in a manner consistent
120 with the escalation of federal funds.

121 SECTION 11. No part of the funds appropriated herein shall
122 be used in the payment of attorney's fees, nor shall any of said
123 funds be used either directly or indirectly, for the purpose of
124 paying any clerk, stenographer, assistant, deputy or other person
125 who may be related by blood or marriage within the third degree,

126 computed by the rules of the civil law, to the official employing
127 or having the right of employment or selection thereof; and in the
128 event of any such payment, then the official or person approving
129 and making or receiving such payment shall be jointly and
130 severally liable to return to the State of Mississippi and to pay
131 into the State Treasury three (3) times any such amount so paid or
132 received, to be recovered at suit of the Attorney General;
133 provided that when the relationship is by affinity and the person
134 through whom the relationship was established is dead, this
135 provision shall not apply.

136 SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
137 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
138 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
139 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
140 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
141 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

142 SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from
143 and after July 1, 2000.
