SENATE BILL NO. 3260

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE 2 DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 3 2001.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as б may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 7 State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the expenses of the Department of Economic and Community Development 8 9 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 10 June 30, 2001.....\$ 28,922,657.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 13 Treasury to the credit of the Department of Economic and Community Development or the appropriate special fund for the purpose of 14 defraying the expenses incurred in the operation of the various 15 divisions of the department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 16 2000 and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 122,195,580.00. 17 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions 18 of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: 19 20 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 21 Full Time.... 330 Permanent: 22 Part Time..... 1 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 23 32 24 Part Time..... 2 25 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of

26 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to

27 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 28 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 29 30 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 31 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 32 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 33 34 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 35 act. that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 36 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 37 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 38 39 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 40 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 41 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 42 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 43 44 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 45 46 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

40 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 47 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 48 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 49 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

50 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 51 amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall 52 be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray 53 the expenses of the Department of Economic and Community 54 Development in operating the state welcome centers.

55 SECTION 5. The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and 56 interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or 57 other orders of or agreements involving any agency,

instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may become available during the fiscal year for the support of the Department of Economic and Community Development or any programs sponsored under the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby authorized not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and

approved, provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and
otherwise accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et
seq., and Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

67 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 68 Department of Economic and Community Development is hereby 69 authorized to escalate and expend funds from any source not to 70 exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with 71 rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and 72 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 73 federal funds.

74 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 75 Department of Economic and Community Development shall maintain 76 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 77 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 78 79 maintained for Fiscal Year 2000. It is further the intention of 80 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2002 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 81 82 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2001 budget request 83 84 process.

SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the amount of Eight Million Nine Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Dollars (\$8,924,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2001. The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.

92 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the 93 amount of Two Million One Hundred Thirty-four Thousand Dollars 94 (\$2,134,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 95 provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and 96 facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2001.

The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be 97 exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972. 98 99 SECTION 10. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 100 101 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 102 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 103 intended mission of this agency. The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section 149 150 are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for 151 support of the Institute for Technology Development to equip, operate and maintain a post-graduate, integrated circuit design, 152 153 engineering training program, known as ComPEET. The funds herein 154 appropriated shall be held separate and apart from all other funds 155 appropriated to the Department of Economic and Community 156 Development. In addition to all other sums herein SECTION 12. 157 158 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 159 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 160 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Economic and Community Development for the purpose of providing 161

funds for Mississippi Technology, Incorporated, for the fiscal

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163 year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$

165 The funds appropriated under the provisions of this section are provided for the specific purpose of providing state funds for 166 167 support of Mississippi Technology, Incorporated, to strengthen the business environment in Mississippi to spur the creation and 168 growth of technology-based industries, thus creating many more 169 170 high-paying jobs and a more diversified, competitive Mississippi 171 economy. The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and 172 apart from all other funds appropriated to the Department of 173 Economic and Community Development.

SECTION 13. In addition to all other sums herein appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated to the Department of Economic and Community Development for support of the Royal Spanish Treasures Exhibit for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001......\$ 1,000,000.00.

181 It is the intention of the Legislature that after all debts 182 for the Majesty of Spain Exhibition have been paid, any excess 183 state funds shall be returned to the State of Mississippi.

184 The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and 185 apart from all other funds appropriated to the Department of 186 Economic and Community Development.

187 SECTION 14. In addition to all other sums herein 188 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 189 190 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 191 Economic and Community Development for the purpose of providing funds to support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce 192 193 Initiative, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000 and ending 194 June 30, 2001.....\$ 2,000,000.00. 195 The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and

196 apart from all other funds appropriated to the Department of 197 Economic and Community Development.

198 SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, One 199 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be used to 200 support the Golden Triangle Education Center for Manufacturing 201 Technology.

202 SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 203 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 204 205 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 206 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 207 208 SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from 209 and after July 1, 2000.
