| 1 2 3 | AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001. |
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| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as |
| 6 | may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the |
| 7 | State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to defray the |
| 8 | expenses of the Department of Economic and Community Development |
| 9 | for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending |
| 10 | June 30, 2001\$ 28,922,657.00. |
| 11 | SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 12 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State |
| 13 | Treasury to the credit of the Department of Economic and Community |
| 14 | Development or the appropriate special fund for the purpose of |
| 15 | defraying the expenses incurred in the operation of the various |
| 16 | divisions of the department for the fiscal year beginning July 1, |
| 17 | 2000 and ending June 30, 2001\$ 122,195,580.00. |
| 18 | SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions |
| 19 | of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized: |
| 20 | AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: |
| 21 | Permanent: Full Time 330 |
| 22 | Part Time 1 |
| 23 | Time-Limited: Full Time |
| 24 | Part Time 2 |
| 25 | With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of |
| 26 | the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to |

- 27 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
- 28 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001
- 29 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
- 30 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the
- 31 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
- 32 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
- 33 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
- 34 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
- 35 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
- 36 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
- 37 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal
- 38 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
- 39 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
- 40 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected
- 41 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services"
- 42 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
- 43 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
- 44 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
- 45 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 47 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 48 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 49 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 50 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the
- 51 amount of Four Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$450,000.00) shall
- 52 be provided from the Motor Carrier Regulation Account to defray
- 53 the expenses of the Department of Economic and Community
- 54 Development in operating the state welcome centers.
- 55 SECTION 5. The acceptance and expenditure of funds, and
- 56 interest on such funds, received from, or by virtue of consent or
- 57 other orders of or agreements involving any agency,
- 58 instrumentality, or judicial tribunal of any state or the United
- 59 States for petroleum price compliance and allocation which may
- 60 become available during the fiscal year for the support of the
- 61 Department of Economic and Community Development or any programs
- 62 sponsored under the terms of the receipt of these funds are hereby
- 63 authorized not to exceed Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) and

- 64 approved, provided such receipts and expenditures are reported and
- otherwise accounted for in accordance with Section 27-103-101 et
- 66 seq., and Section 27-104-1 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 67 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 68 Department of Economic and Community Development is hereby
- 69 authorized to escalate and expend funds from any source not to
- 70 exceed Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) in accordance with
- 71 rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
- 72 Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
- 73 federal funds.
- 74 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 75 Department of Economic and Community Development shall maintain
- 76 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- 77 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 78 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- 79 maintained for Fiscal Year 2000. It is further the intention of
- 80 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 81 2002 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 82 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 83 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2001 budget request
- 84 process.
- 85 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the
- 86 amount of Eight Million Nine Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Dollars
- 87 (\$8,924,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
- 88 provided for the purpose of supporting Mississippi Tourism
- 89 Advertising and Promotion for Fiscal Year 2001. The expenditure
- 90 of funds authorized in this section shall be exempt from Section
- 91 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 92 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, the
- 93 amount of Two Million One Hundred Thirty-four Thousand Dollars
- 94 (\$2,134,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
- 95 provided for the purpose of supporting, marketing, and
- 96 facilitating Mississippi business growth for Fiscal Year 2001.

| 97 | The expenditure of funds authorized in this section shall be |
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| 98 | exempt from Section 25-9-120, Mississippi Code of 1972. |
| 99 | SECTION 10. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance |
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| 100 | Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of |
| 101 | the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized |
| 102 | in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the |
| 103 | intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, |
| 104 | this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted |

| 183 | state funds shall be returned to the State of Mississippi. |
| 184 | The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and |
| 185 | apart from all other funds appropriated to the Department of |
| 186 | Economic and Community Development. |
| 187 | SECTION 14. In addition to all other sums herein |
| 188 | appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be |
| 189 | necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State |
| 190 | General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of |
| 191 | Economic and Community Development for the purpose of providing |
| 192 | funds to support the Stennis Space Center - Space Commerce |

| 195 | The funds herein appropriated shall be held separate and |

- 196 apart from all other funds appropriated to the Department of
- 197 Economic and Community Development.
- 198 SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, One
- 199 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be used to
- 200 support the Golden Triangle Education Center for Manufacturing
- 201 Technology.
- SECTION 16. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 203 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 204 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 205 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 206 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 207 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 208 SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 209 and after July 1, 2000.
