SENATE BILL NO. 3263 (As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE STATE 2 TREASURY FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI 3 FARMERS CENTRAL MARKET, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as б may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the 7 State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Farmers Central Market, to defray the expenses of said Farmers Central Market and 8 9 to provide for the payment of any indebtedness which may accrue 10 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 458,754.00. 11 June 30, 2001.....\$ 12 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 13 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of 14 15 expenditure: MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE: 16 17 Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits...\$ 293,479.00 18 Travel and Subsistence..... 1,500.00 19 20 Contractual Services..... 118,825.00 Commodities..... 14,850.00 21 22 Capital Outlay: Other Than Equipment..... 0.00 23 Equipment..... 11,100.00 24 Subsidies, Loans and Grants..... 25 19,000.00 26 Total.....\$ 458,754.00

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 32 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 34 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 37 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 40 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 41 42 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure act. 43 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 44 45 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 46 47 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 48 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 49 50 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 51 52 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 53 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 54 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 55 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 56 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 58

59 Provided, however, that all funds received from any and all

S. B. No. 3263 00\SS08\A408 PAGE 2 60 sources shall be deposited in a special fund in the State Treasury 61 to the credit of the Mississippi Farmers Central Market.

62 SECTION 3. The board shall promulgate and adopt reasonable rules and regulations, including employing attendants, to regulate 63 64 and provide for the parking of motor vehicles at the farm produce marketing facility near the Mississippi Memorial Stadium for 65 regularly scheduled football games, and said board shall make said 66 facility available for such purpose and shall make a reasonable 67 68 charge therefor comparable to the charge made for parking in the 69 area contiguous to the stadium. The net proceeds from such parking shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of 70 71 the Mississippi Farmers Central Market and shall be used solely for general maintenance and repair of the Central Market 72 73 facilities.

74 SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 75 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 76 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 77 78 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 79 80 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2000. 81

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
