Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 68 69 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 70 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 71 act. 72 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 73 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 74 75 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 76 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 77 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 78 79 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 80 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 81 82 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 83 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 84 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 88 89 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 90 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 91 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 92 93 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 94 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 95 and after July 1, 2000.

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
