28 Total.....\$ 4,004,709.00 AUTHORIZED POSITIONS: 29 30 Full Time.... 17 Permanent: 31 Part Time..... 42 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 32 0 Part Time..... 33 0 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 34 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 35 36 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 37 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions 38 39 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 40 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 41 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 42 43 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this

that no single personnel action increases this projected annual 45 46 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, 47 48 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 49 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 50 51 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation 52 53 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until such time as the requirements of this provision are met. 54

It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure

57 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 58 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 59 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 60 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. No operation, maintenance or service contracts, agreements or obligations for commodities, concessions, or catering services, shall be entered into or renewed by this agency for a period of more than three (3) years nor unless said contracts, agreements or obligations have been made in accordance with Sections 31-7-11, 31-7-13, 31-7-55 and 31-7-57, Mississippi Code of 1972.

SECTION 4. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

75 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from 76 and after July 1, 2000.

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
