SENATE BILL NO. 3268 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI FAIR 1 2 COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE DIXIE 3 NATIONAL LIVESTOCK SHOW; A ROUNDUP FOR JUNIOR EXHIBITORS OF LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY; SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDS FOR LIVESTOCK PREMIUMS; 4 5 COUNTY LIVESTOCK SHOWS IN OFFERING AND PAYING PRIZES OR AWARDS TO 6 COMPETITORS IN APPROVED COUNTY LIVESTOCK SHOWS; THE FIVE DISTRICT 7 LIVESTOCK SHOWS; THE FIVE STATE DAIRY SHOWS; THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL RODEO; AND TO PROVIDE HOW SAID MONEY SHALL BE PAID OUT OF 8 9 THE STATE TREASURY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 12 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Fair Commission's 13 special fund account, to the Mississippi Fair Commission for the 14 15 purposes of defraying the costs of prizes, premiums, judges and 16 other actual and necessary costs of putting on the Dixie National Livestock Show at the State Fairgrounds in Jackson, Mississippi, 17 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 18 June 30, 2001\$ 924,800.00. 19 SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be 20 necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 21 General Fund, not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi Fair 22 23 Commission as follows: 24 (a) For the support of annual roundup shows for junior 25 exhibitors of junior steers, junior breeding cattle, beef cattle, dairy cattle, hogs, sheep and poultry, for the fiscal year2001 26 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... 27\$ 72,984.00. 28 29 (b) To supplement the funds paid by the Mississippi Fair 30 Commission for livestock premiums at the State Fair, all livestock 31 premiums to be paid on the American system of judging (1st, 2nd, 32 3rd, 4th, etc.) on all classes entered in the senior division for 33 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.. 34\$29,697.00.

35 (c) For the county livestock shows in offering and
36 paying prizes or awards to competitors in the approved county
37 livestock shows of Mississippi, for the fiscal year beginning
38 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 15,838.00.

Provided, however, that of the amount herein appropriated in 39 subsection (c), not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) 40 41 shall be expended or used in any one county of the state during each fiscal year. Provided, further, that none of the moneys 42 43 herein appropriated in subsection (c) shall be used in offering or paying prizes or awards for any livestock show that is not held 44 45 where there are adequate barns, pens and other facilities 46 available for such a show.

Provided further, in subsection (c) that the management of 47 such shows shall be in the hands of a county livestock 48 association, and such association shall guarantee a minimum amount 49 50 of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to be used in the paying of prizes, premiums or awards, and after said county show has been 51 52 held and premiums paid, fifty percent (50%) of the amount, not 53 exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), shall be paid upon 54 requisition to the Mississippi Fair Commission.

Provided further, in subsection (c) that in any county which has two (2) shows with proper facilities, and a contiguous county has no such fair and desires to participate in a fair to be held in an adjoining county, each of the two (2) fairs in one county may receive an equal proportion of the funds hereby appropriated, provided, both shows shall not receive an aggregate sum of more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

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(d) For the purpose of offering awards and prizes to

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fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....

(e) For the purpose of offering awards and prizes to
competitors in the five (5) state dairy shows as provided in
Section 69-5-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal
year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....

71 Provided further, that no part of the money herein 72 appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall 73 be used for any other purpose than to pay premium awards at said 74 shows and state shows and expositions receiving legislative 75 appropriation shall not conflict in dates in order that livestock 76 exhibitors may make the circuit of shows. Provided further, that 77 none of the above mentioned funds shall be paid to any district 78 shows unless shows are held prior to roundup.

Not less than seventy-five percent (75%) of the funds herein appropriated under the provisions of subsections (d) and (e) shall be used in awarding prizes or premiums to 4-H Club members and Smith-Hughes School members and other boys and girls having entries in said shows.

All funds herein appropriated under the provisions of 84 85 subsections (d) and (e) for the five (5) district livestock shows and the five (5) Fall state dairy shows shall be distributed in 86 such manner that the livestock exhibitors will each draw equal 87 88 premium awards for comparable grades and placings at each of the 89 said five (5) district Spring shows and the five (5) Fall state shows. The management of each district Spring show and each state 90 Fall show shall submit to the Mississippi Fair Commission, within 91 92 fifteen (15) days after the close of each said show, a full report 93 on the number of exhibitors at each said show, with the grades and placings of the different classes of livestock exhibited. 94

95 The Executive Secretary of the Mississippi Fair Commission,

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96 together with a committee of three (3) to be named by the 97 President of the Mississippi Livestock Council from that organization, shall summarize and prepare a unified list of awards 98 for like classes in all Spring district livestock shows and Fall 99 100 state dairy shows receiving state premium money, as authorized in The Executive Secretary and Chairman of 101 subsections (d) and (e). 102 the Mississippi Fair Commission shall approve and present a 103 requisition to the State Fiscal Officer for the payment of the amount of funds in subsections (d) and (e) due each show and said 104 105 State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrant thereon, and it shall 106 be paid by the State Treasurer.

107 Provided, however, as a condition of expenditure of the funds appropriated in subsections (d) and (e), that the board of 108 109 directors of any district livestock show may, in its discretion, 110 choose to hold its show in the Fall instead of the Spring. Ιf 111 district shows are held in both Spring and Fall, then all funds 112 herein appropriated for the five (5) district livestock shows shall be distributed in such a manner that the Spring livestock 113 114 exhibitors will each draw equal premium awards for comparable 115 grades and placings at each district Spring show, and the Fall 116 livestock exhibitors will each draw equal premium awards for comparable grades and placings at each district Fall show. 117

(f) For promotion and expenses of the winners of the Mississippi High School Rodeo for attending the national finals, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 9,899.00.

122 (g) For the promotion and expenses of the seafood rodeo 123 in Biloxi known as the Shrimp Festival, for the fiscal year 124 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 4,939.00.

126 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 127 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 128 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon

No. 3268 00\SS08\A435 PAGE 4 129 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 130 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 131 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 132 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 133 and after July 1, 2000.
