1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 2 MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI AGRICULTURAL AND FORESTRY 3 EXPERIMENT STATION FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Mississippi Agricultural and Forestry 8 9 Experiment Station for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 10 21,836,508.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 13 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi 14 Agricultural and Forestry Experiment Station for the fiscal year 15 beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... 16 .....\$ 17 8,050,751.00. SECTION 3. No general funds authorized to be expended herein 18 shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds 19 20 which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 21 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that if 22

the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly or indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants, research grants or donations, such special source funds not classified as current restricted funds shall be added and

S. B. No. 3270 00\SS05\A422 PAGE 1 27 accounted for under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the 28 intention of the Legislature that all such aforementioned special source funds be included in all reports and requests for the 2001 29 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature. 30

31 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for fiscal year 2002 shall be submitted to 32 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 33 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 34 during the fiscal year 2001 budget request process. 35

SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 36 following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement 37 Fund as follows: 38

39 (a) One Million Five Hundred Thirty-eight Thousand One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$1,538,110.00) shall be derived 40 from funds deposited pursuant to Sections 41 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972. 42

(b) One Hundred Four Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars (\$104,667.00) shall be derived from funds 44 deposited pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1), 45 46 Mississippi Code of 1972.

47 SECTION 7. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 48 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 49 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 50 51 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 52

No. 3270 00\SS05\A422 PAGE 3 97 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 98 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 99 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 100 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 101 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 102 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from 103 and after July 1, 2000.
