## SENATE BILL NO. 3272 (As Passed the Senate)

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and
8	maintenance of the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service for
9	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000 and ending June 30, 2001
LO	\$ 23,624,028.00.
L1	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L2	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
L3	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
L4	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi
L5	Cooperative Extension Service for the fiscal year beginning
L6	July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001
L7	\$ 13,024,274.00.
L8	SECTION 3. No general funds authorized to be expended herein
L9	shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds
20	which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions
21	of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
22	SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
23	Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service provide programs in the
24	emphasis areas of Agriculture, Home Economics, 4-H, and Community
25	Resource Development in each county.
26	SECTION 5. No part of the funds appropriated or authorized

- 27 to be expended hereby shall be spent directly or indirectly for
- 28 payment of attorneys' fees for the services of any attorney who
- 29 was not employed by the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service
- 30 pursuant to the express authorization of the Board of Trustees of
- 31 Institutions of Higher Learning prior to performance of such legal
- 32 services.
- 33 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 34 agency's budget request for fiscal year 2002 shall be submitted to
- 35 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 36 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 37 during the fiscal year 2001 budget request process.
- 38 SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that if the
- 39 funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly or
- 40 indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants,
- 41 research grants or donations, such special source funds not
- 42 classified as current restricted funds shall be added and
- 43 accounted for under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the
- 44 intention of the Legislature that all such aforementioned special
- 45 source funds be included in all reports and requests for the 2001
- 46 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature.
- 47 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the
- 48 following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement
- 49 Fund as follows:
- 50 (a) One Million Two Hundred Thirty-six Thousand Nine
- Hundred Forty-three Dollars (\$1,236,943.00)
- shall be derived from funds deposited pursuant
- to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi
- 54 Code of 1972.
- 55 (b) One Hundred Fifty-two Thousand Sixty-seven
- Dollars (\$152,067.00) shall be derived from
- funds deposited pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1),
- 58 Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 59 SECTION 9. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance

60	Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
61	the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
62	in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
63	intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
64	this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
65	performance measures provided below:

88	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
89	the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seventy-five Thousand Dollars
90	(\$75,000.00) shall be allocated to the Delta Branch Research and
91	Extension Station for a Cotton Specialist and the related
92	supportive costs.

- 93 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
- 94 the funds appropriated in Section 1 and authorized for expenditure
- 95 in Section 2, Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be
- 96 allocated to defray the costs of the Northeast Mississippi Swine
- 97 Demonstration Unit located at the Pontotoc Branch Experiment
- 98 Station.
- 99 SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
- 100 the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, an
- 101 Extension Beef Specialist position shall be funded.
- 102 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
- 103 the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, an Area
- 104 Aquaculture Agent for East Central Mississippi shall be funded.
- 105 SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
- 106 the funds authorized for expenditures in Section 2, One Hundred
- 107 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be allocated to defray
- 108 the costs of the Extension Youth Livestock Program at Mississippi
- 109 State University.
- 110 SECTION 15. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
- 111 the funds appropriated in Section 1, Two Hundred Fifty Thousand
- 112 Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be allocated to defray the costs of
- 113 operating the Crosby Arboretum.
- 114 SECTION 16. Should revenues generated and deposited to the
- 115 Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1),
- 116 Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein
- 117 from said source, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
- 118 Higher Learning shall notify the Department of Finance and
- 119 Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced to insure
- 120 that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.
- 121 SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that of
- 122 the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, the
- 123 amount of Four Hundred Seventy-seven Thousand Dollars
- 124 (\$477,000.00) shall be allocated to defray the cost of the Grow
- 125 Green Program. Funds for this program shall be allocated to fund

- 126 a Turf Specialist and an Area Horticulture Specialist.
- 127 SECTION 18. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
- of Section 1, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be
- 129 allocated to defray the costs of a Production Economist at the
- 130 Delta Research and Extension Center at Stoneville, Mississippi.
- 131 SECTION 19. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 132 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 133 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 134 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 135 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 136 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 137 SECTION 20. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 138 and after July 1, 2000.
