SENATE BILL NO. 3272 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPORT AND 2 MAINTENANCE OF THE MISSISSIPPI COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE FOR 3 FISCAL YEAR 2001.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service for 8 9 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000 and ending June 30, 2001 10 24,097,530.00. SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special 13 source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi 14 Cooperative Extension Service for the fiscal year beginning 15 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001..... 16\$ 13,074,274.00. 17 SECTION 3. No general funds authorized to be expended herein 18 shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds 19 20 which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions

21 of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

22 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 23 Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service provide programs in the 24 emphasis areas of Agriculture, Home Economics, 4-H, and Community 25 Resource Development in each county.

26 SECTION 5. No part of the funds appropriated or authorized

No. 3272 00\SS02\A421SG PAGE 1 to be expended hereby shall be spent directly or indirectly for payment of attorneys' fees for the services of any attorney who was not employed by the Mississippi Cooperative Extension Service pursuant to the express authorization of the Board of Trustees of Institutions of Higher Learning prior to performance of such legal services.

33 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 34 agency's budget request for fiscal year 2002 shall be submitted to 35 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 36 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 37 during the fiscal year 2001 budget request process.

38 SECTION 7. It is the intent of the Legislature that if the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act are used directly or 39 40 indirectly to match or otherwise secure any federal grants, research grants or donations, such special source funds not 41 42 classified as current restricted funds shall be added and 43 accounted for under Section 2 of this act. Further, it is the intention of the Legislature that all such aforementioned special 44 45 source funds be included in all reports and requests for the 2001 Regular Session of the Mississippi Legislature. 46

47 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, the 48 following amounts shall be derived from the Education Enhancement 49 Fund as follows:

59 SECTION 9. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance

Dollars (\$152,067.00) shall be derived from

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Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 60 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 61 62 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 88 the funds appropriated in Section 1, Seventy-five Thousand Dollars 89 90 (\$75,000.00) shall be allocated to the Delta Branch Research and Extension Station for a Cotton Specialist and the related 91

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supportive costs.

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93 SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 94 the funds appropriated in Section 1 and authorized for expenditure 95 in Section 2, Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be 96 allocated to defray the costs of the Northeast Mississippi Swine 97 Demonstration Unit located at the Pontotoc Branch Experiment 98 Station.

99 SECTION 12. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 100 the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, an 101 Extension Beef Specialist position shall be funded.

102 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 103 the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, an Area 104 Aquaculture Agent for East Central Mississippi shall be funded.

105 SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 106 the funds authorized for expenditures in Section 2, One Hundred 107 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) shall be allocated to defray 108 the costs of the Extension Youth Livestock Program at Mississippi 109 State University.

110 SECTION 15. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 111 the funds appropriated in Section 1, Two Hundred Fifty Thousand 112 Dollars (\$250,000.00) shall be allocated to defray the costs of 113 operating the Crosby Arboretum.

SECTION 16. Should revenues generated and deposited to the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1), Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein from said source, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall notify the Department of Finance and Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced to insure that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.

121 SECTION 17. It is the intention of the Legislature that of 122 the funds appropriated under the provisions of this act, the 123 amount of Four Hundred Seventy-seven Thousand Dollars 124 (\$477,000.00) shall be allocated to defray the cost of the Grow 125 Green Program. Funds for this program shall be allocated to fund

SECTION 18. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 127 128 of Section 1, One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) shall be allocated to defray the costs of a Production Economist at the 129 130 Delta Research and Extension Center at Stoneville, Mississippi. SECTION 19. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 131 of Section 1, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) shall 132 be allocated to defray the cost of three (3) Poultry Specialists. 133 134 None of these funds may be expended until an unbiased report 135 is filed quarterly with the Lieutenant Governor, the Speaker of the House, the Chairman of the Senate Agriculture Committee and 136 137 the House Agriculture Committee that details the status of the Integrator/Grower relationship and any problems that may arise 138 139 relating to that relationship.

SECTION 20. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 140 141 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 142 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 143 144 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 145 146 SECTION 21. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2000. 147
