The following sum, or so much thereof as may be б necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for payment of the expenses of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi 8 9 Department of Public Safety, created by Section 41-29-101 et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning 10 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 12,015,775.00. 11 12 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 13 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the 14 Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi Department of 15 Public Safety which is comprised of special source funds collected 16 17 by or otherwise available to the agency, for the support and maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year beginning 18 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 1,342,765.00. 19 20 SECTION 3. 45	the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
46	make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 66 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 67 68 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 69 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 70 71 SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 72 73 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 74 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 75 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 76 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 77 performance measures provided below: 78 Performance Measures FY2001 Target 79 Drug Enforcement 80 Cases Initiated (Cases) 3,984 Arrests Made (Persons) 2,096 81 82 Drug Education/Training Events (Events) 483 A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets 83 set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the 84 85 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee for Fiscal Year 2002. 86 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 87 Section 2, funds are included to defray the costs of clothing for 88 89 sworn law enforcement officers in an amount not to exceed One 90 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually per officer.

91 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the 92 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the

No. 3278 00\SS08\A718 PAGE 3 93 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 94 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 95 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 96 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 97 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and 98 after July 1, 2000.
