SENATE BILL NO. 3278
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUPPORT OF THE MISSISSIPPI
2 BUREAU OF NARCOTICS OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY
3 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2001.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for payment of the
8 expenses of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi
9 Department of Public Safety, created by Section 41-29-101 et seq.,
10 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning
11 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 12,079,783.00.

12 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
13 necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any money
14 in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the
15 Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics of the Mississippi Department of
16 Public Safety which is comprised of special source funds collected
17 by or otherwise available to the agency, for the support and
18 maintenance of the agency for the fiscal year beginning
19 July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 1,342,765.00.

20 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
21 Sections 1 and 2, not more than the amounts set forth below shall
22 be expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
23 expenditure:

44 With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of
45 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to
46 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal
47 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001
48 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions
49 are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the
50 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the
51 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall
52 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all
53 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this
54 act. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure
55 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual
56 cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal
57 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month,
58 the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken
59 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected

60 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services"
61 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which
62 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation
63 requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until
64 such time as the requirements of this provision are met.

65 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
66 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

67 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
68 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
69 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
70 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

71 SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
72 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
73 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
74 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
75 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,
76 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted
77 performance measures provided below:

83 A reporting of the degree to which the performance targets
84 set above have been or are being achieved shall be provided in the
85 agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget
86 Committee for Fiscal Year 2002.

87 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
88 Section 2, funds are included to defray the costs of clothing for
89 sworn law enforcement officers in an amount not to exceed One
90 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) annually per officer.

91 SECTION 6. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
92 necessary, is hereby reappropriated out of any money in the State

93 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Bureau of
94 Narcotics of the Mississippi Department of Public Safety for the
95 purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of State General Funds,
96 as authorized in Senate Bill No. 3160, Regular Session of 1999,
97 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30,
98 2001 \$ 1,000,000.00.

99 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the
100 provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended
101 exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2000.

102 SECTION 7. With the funds provided in this act, the Bureau
103 of Narcotics may conduct a Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics
104 Training Academy approved and certified by the Board on Law
105 Enforcement Officers Standards and Training.

106 SECTION 8. The Director of the Bureau of Narcotics may on a
107 case by case basis, within the funds available, recommend that
108 corrective salary adjustments be made to the compensation of
109 employees of the Bureau of Narcotics where an inequity was created
110 between employees of equivalent capacity by previous application
111 of the agency appropriation acts. Any such corrective salary
112 adjustment must have prior approval by the State Personnel Board.
113 Such adjustments will not be retroactive.

114 SECTION 9. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the
115 State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
116 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
117 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
118 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
119 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

120 SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from
121 and after July 1, 2000.
