1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 6 7 defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the Veterans Affairs Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending 8 9 June 30, 2001.....\$ 3,413,466.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special 12 fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Veterans Affairs Board which is comprised of special source funds collected by or 13 otherwise available to the board, for the support and maintenance 14 of said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and 15 16 ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 19,912,853.00. 17 SECTION 3. With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 41 42 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to 43 make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 44 45 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 46 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the 47 Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 48 49 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 50 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 51 act. 52 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 53 54 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 55 56 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected 57 annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 58 59 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation

62 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 63 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

68 SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 69 Section 1, and authorized for expenditure in Section 3, funds in 70 the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars

(\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the cost of providing care to indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans in the state veterans homes. This section and its provisions shall be known and cited as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance Act of 1997."

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2000.

85 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that none 86 of the funds appropriated in this act shall be used to pay 87 Pharmacy Technicians.

SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the

94 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from
95 and after July 1, 2000.
