4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the administrative fund of the
8	Mississippi Employment Security Commission, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses incurred by said commission for the fiscal
10	year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001
11	\$ 74,523,076.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
14	expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
15	expenditure:

With the funds herein appropriated, it is the intention of 32 33 the Legislature that it shall be the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal 34 35 Services" for Fiscal Year 2002 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2001 36 funds appropriated for that purpose, unless programs or positions are added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2002 budget by the 37 38 Mississippi Legislature. Based on data provided by the Legislative Budget Office, the State Personnel Board shall 39 determine and publish the projected annual cost to fully fund all 40 appropriated positions in compliance with the provisions of this 41 42 It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to insure 43 that no single personnel action increases this projected annual cost and/or the Fiscal Year 2001 appropriation for "Personal 44 45 Services" when annualized. If, at the end of any calendar month, the State Personnel Board determines that the agency has taken 46 47 action(s) which would cause the agency to exceed this projected annual cost or the Fiscal Year 2001 "Personal Services" 48 appropriated level, when annualized, then only those actions which 49 50 reduce the projected annual cost and/or the appropriation requirement will be processed by the State Personnel Board until 51 52 such time as the requirements of this provision are met. Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 53 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. 54 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 55 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 56 57 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. 58 59 SECTION 3. In addition to any other funds appropriated

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60 herein, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
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- 61 is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Unemployment Trust
- 62 Fund, made available to this state under Section 903 of the Social
- 63 Security Act, as amended, to the Employment Security Commission to
- 64 be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund for
- 65 use by the Employment Security Commission, under the direction of

- 71 provisions of Section 3 shall be requisitioned by the Employment

- 73 the Secretary of the Treasury of the United States as needed for
- 74 the payment of obligations incurred under this appropriation, and
- 75 such monies shall be deposited in the Employment Security
- 76 Administration Fund in accordance with the provisions of Section
- 77 71-5-457, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 78 SECTION 5. In addition to any other funds appropriated
- 79 herein, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
- 80 is hereby appropriated out of funds in the Special Employment
- 81 Security Administration Fund to the Employment Security Commission
- 82 for its use as provided in Section 71-5-114, Mississippi Code of
- 83 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending
- 84 June 30, 2001.....\$2,075,000.00.
- 85 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated under the
- 86 provisions of Section 5 shall be requisitioned by the Employment
- 87 Security Commission from the Special Employment Security
- 88 Administration Fund as needed for the payment of obligations
- 89 incurred under this appropriation, and such monies requisitioned
- 90 shall be deposited in the Employment Security Administration Fund
- 91 upon receipt.
- 92 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in this act, a total of

- 93 Nine Million Dollars (\$9,000,000.00) is provided for the purpose
- 94 of acquiring land, constructing or lease purchasing a new
- 95 headquarters facility for the Mississippi Employment Security
- 96 Commission, and paying for any costs associated with the
- 97 acquisition of land, construction of facilities, and any
- 98 relocation expenses. The funds authorized in this section shall
- 99 be under the direction of the Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real
- 100 Property Management.
- 101 SECTION 8. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 102 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 103 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 104 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 105 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 106 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 107 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 108 and after July 1, 2000.
