64 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 65 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, funds in the amount of Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) shall be deposited into the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund for the purpose of assisting counties and municipalities in the replacement and rehabilitation of certain bridges located on local road systems in the counties and in municipalities within the counties.

77 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 78 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 79 80 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 81 82 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 83 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2000. 84
