SENATE BILL NO. 3295

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS TO DEFRAY THE
2 EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF VETERINARY EXAMINERS
3 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2001.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 SECTION 1. That the following sum, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of
8 Veterinary Examiners for the purpose of defraying the expenses
9 incurred by said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000,
10 and ending June 30, 2001.....\$ 118,560.00.

11 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12 Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be
13 expended for the respective major objects or purposes of
14 expenditure:

15 MAJOR OBJECTS OF EXPENDITURE:

16 Personal Services:

17 Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits...\$ 6,000.00
18 Travel and Subsistence..... 16,480.00
19 Contractual Services..... 93,580.00
20 Commodities..... 2,500.00

21 Capital Outlay:

22 Other Than Equipment..... 0.00
23 Equipment..... 0.00
24 Subsidies, Loans and Grants.....0.00
25 Total.....\$ 118,560.00

26 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

27 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

28 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
29 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
30 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
31 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

32 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
33 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
34 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
35 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
36 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
37 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

38 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
39 and after July 1, 2000.
