SENATE BILL NO. 3324

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JACKSON
2 COUNTY TO PURCHASE RADAR SPEED DETECTION EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE
3 SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF THE COUNTY IN THE ENFORCEMENT OF SPEED
4 LIMITS ON THE ROADS, STREETS AND HIGHWAYS OF THE COUNTY OUTSIDE
5 THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF ANY INCORPORATED MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR
6 RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors of Jackson County,
9 Mississippi, may expend out of any available funds of the county,
10 an amount that the board determines is sufficient for the purchase
11 of and use by the sheriff's department of the county of radar
12 speed detection equipment. If the board of supervisors authorizes
13 the expenditure of funds for such purpose, then the Sheriff of
14 Jackson County and any duly sworn deputy sheriff of the county may
15 operate and use such equipment to enforce the motor vehicle speed
16 limits on any public road, street or highway within the county
17 outside the corporate limits of any incorporated municipality.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
19 and after its passage.
