SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 509

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 70,
- 2 MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890, TO PROVIDE THAT BILLS REDUCING
- 3 TAXES REQUIRE A MAJORITY VOTE FOR PASSAGE.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 5 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 6 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 7 state:
- 8 Amend Section 70, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 9 as follows:
- 10 Section 70. No revenue bill, or any bill providing for
- 11 assessments of property for taxation, shall become a law except by
- 12 a vote of at least three-fifths (3/5) of the members of each house
- 13 present and voting. Passage of any bill providing for the
- 14 reduction of taxes shall require a majority vote of the members of
- 15 <u>each house present and voting for passage.</u>
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the qualified electors at an election to be held on
- 18 the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 2000 in the
- 19 manner provided by Section 273 of the Constitution and by law.
- 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of the amendment
- 21 for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed amendment

- 22 provides that bills reducing taxes will require a majority vote
- 23 for passage."
