SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 524 (As Adopted by Senate)

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE PUBLIC SERVICE CAREER 2 OF PORT GIBSON MAYOR JAMES BEESLEY UPON THE OCCASION OF HIS 3 RETIREMENT.
