- 5 WHEREAS, Perry Kenneth Quinn, Superintendent of the New
- 6 Albany Public School District since 1992, has been selected as
- 7 Mississippi's Superintendent of the Year 2000; and

- 10 in to the state association from which one winner is selected to

- 20 Quinn's "open-door policy" for all students, teachers, parents and
- 21 the community as extremely commendable and for making students the
- 22 most important priority in the school operation for the innovative
- 23 strategies of instruction resulting in the significant growth in
- 24 student academic performance; and
- WHEREAS, during the 1998-1999 school year, the district was
- 26 selected as one of the ten most improved districts in the State of
- 27 Mississippi, earning the highest level 5.0 accreditation; and
