- 3 ITS OUTSTANDING 1999 SEASON AND IMPRESSIVE VICTORY IN THE 1999
- 4 LIBERTY BOWL.
- 5 WHEREAS, defense wins championships, and the University of
- 6 Southern Mississippi's 1999 Golden Eagles Football team's defense
- 7 shut down Colorado State University in the 1999 Liberty Bowl
- 8 resulting in a 23-17 victory which was the culmination of a season
- 9 with the highest final ranking in school history;
- 10 WHEREAS, here are the achievements of the Southern
- 11 Mississippi Football Team in 1999:
- 12 Coach Jeff Bower was named the Conference USA Coach
- 13 of the Year for the second time;
- 14 Adalius Thomas was named Conference USA's Defensive
- 15 Player of the Year for the second straight season and
- 16 has been named to six All-American teams in 1999;
- 17 The Golden Eagles placed five players on Conference USA's
- 18 First Team (Shederick Blackmon, Cedric Scott, Adalius Thomas, T.J.
- 19 Slaughter and Leo Barnes); six players on Conference USA's Second
- 20 Team (Derrick Nix, Sherrod Gideon, Todd Pinkston, DeQuincy Scott,
- 21 Ty Trahan, Terrance Parrish) and five players on Conference USA's
- 22 All-Freshman Team (Zeb Landers, Torrin Tucker, Buck Miciotto, Joe

- 23 Henley and Jeremy Bridges);
- 24 Southern Miss quarterback Jeff Kelly finished the year with
- 25 21 touchdown passes which was second behind Lee Roberts and ahead
- 26 of Brett Favre on the USM single season list;
- 27 Southern Miss finished the bowl season with its highest final
- 28 ranking in school history at No. 13 in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches
- 29 Top 25 Poll;
- 30 Southern Miss running back Derrick Nix became the first
- 31 sophomore in Southern Miss history to rush for 1,000 or more yards
- 32 in his first two seasons. He is only the second USM running back
- 33 to record consecutive 1,000 yard seasons;
- 34 Southern Miss wide receiver Sherrod Gideon finished his
- 35 Golden Eagle career as the school's leader in receptions (193),
- 36 receiving yardage (3,215) and touchdown receptions (30);
- 37 Southern Miss' Adalius Thomas is the school's all-time leader
- 38 in quarterback sacks with 34.5;
- 39 Southern Miss' defense held No. 2 ranked Nebraska to its
- 40 lowest yardage output since the 1993 season and held the Huskers
- 41 to eight first downs, their lowest total since the 1968 season;
- 42 Southern Miss was named the USA Today Team of the Week after
- 43 the Golden Eagles' 39-22 victory over No. 16 East Carolina on
- 44 October 9;
- 45 Southern Miss was perfect at home this season with a 5-0
- 46 record;
- 47 Southern Miss had six players named Conference USA Player of
- 48 the Week during the season: Roy Magee, T.J. Slaughter, Leo
- 49 Barnes, Adalius Thomas, Ty Trahan and Brant Hanna;
- 50 Southern Miss' defense finished the year ranked eighth in the
- 51 nation in total defense;
- Adalius Thomas was named the Liberty Bowl's Most Valuable
- 53 Player and the game's Most Valuable Defensive Player, while

- 54 quarterback Jeff Kelly was named the Liberty Bowl Offensive MVP;
- Southern Miss is sending a school record five players to play
- in the Delchamp's Senior Bowl, college football's most prestigious
- 57 all-star game. Those players are Adalius Thomas, Todd Pinkston,
- 58 Terrance Parrish, Sherrod Gideon and T.J. Slaughter;
- 59 Adalius Thomas was named the Bronko Nagurski National Defensive
- 60 Player of the Week for his performance on October 23 against
- 61 Cincinnati;
- 62 Southern Miss won its third Conference USA Championship in
- 63 four seasons;
- Southern Miss played in its third consecutive bowl game, a
- 65 school record for consecutive bowl appearances;
- Southern Miss improved to a perfect 2-0 in the Liberty Bowl;

- 68 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this
- 69 talented group of student athletes who have brought great honor to
- 70 their university, their community and to the State of Mississippi:
