SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 562

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE NEED TO INFORM MEDICAL PROVIDERS OF THE MEANS TO COMBAT ANTIBIOTIC RESISTANCE, 1 2 3 AND URGING THE CARE PROVIDERS TO ADOPT THE CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL GUIDELINES. 4 WHEREAS, antibiotic-resistant infections are more likely to 5 produce adverse health outcomes and are more costly to treat than 6 7 susceptible infections; and WHEREAS, the widespread use of antibiotics has increased the 8 type and incidence of bacteria that are resistant to treatment by 9 10 antibiotics; and WHEREAS, antibiotic resistance is caused by the overuse of 11 12 antibiotics in general, with overuse of selected agents in 13 particular; and WHEREAS, over the past five years the rate of penicillin 14 15 resistance increased by more than 300% and the rate of cefotaxime resistance increased by more than 1,000%; and 16 17 WHEREAS, patients infected with antibiotic-resistant strains of bacteria can require hospitalization when otherwise unnecessary 18 19 and be subject to an increased rate of death; and 20 WHEREAS, the process of creating antibiotic-resistance increases pharmaceutical costs through inappropriate prescribing 21 22 of antibiotic agents and increases total healthcare costs the additional hospitalization and other forms of additional medical 23 care required in the treatment of resistant strains of bacteria; 24 25 and WHEREAS, the federal Centers for Disease Control and 26 Prevention (CDC) and American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) have 27

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That the State of Mississippi endorses the CDC/AAP recommendations and urges each health care professional and managed care plan operating in Mississippi to adopt the recommendations in their practice and formularies.
